- ▶ Register on **both** portals separately — one does not cover the other.
- ▶ State merit list (not AIR alone) decides Maharashtra state-quota allotment; category, domicile & documents matter.
- ▶ Never exit counselling after Round 1 — cutoffs typically relax in later & stray rounds.
- ▶ NEET-based alternatives with lower cutoffs: BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS, BVSc — legitimate careers, same counselling ecosystem.

Scores are inflated this year, so **2026 closing marks will very likely be HIGHER than the 2025 figures in Table 3**. Treat every college figure as a floor, not a promise.
